Dual-Flush Toilet Conversion Kit Rebate Program
Conditions and Guidelines

Dual-flush conversion kits are recommended for use on modern 1.6 gallon per flush (GPF) toilets in good working condition. If you have an older 3.5 or higher GPF toilet, you will get superior flush power and greater water-savings by taking advantage of our toilet replacement rebate. However, where an older toilet cannot be replaced, a conversion kit may still be worthwhile.

Only “dual flush conversion kits,” such as HydroRight, One2Flush, Fluidmaster Conversion Kit, etc. are eligible for rebates (trade names offered as examples and are NOT recommendations). Early-close toilet flappers are not eligible.

The applicant must be a residential water customer of record for an active, non-delinquent account. The kit must be installed at the property where the water is delivered.

The property owner is solely responsible for ensuring proper installation and compliance with the Massachusetts plumbing code.

A copy of your receipt must accompany the rebate application.

Rebates of up to \$10 per kit for purchase costs will be issued as a credit on your next water bill.

Maximum of two kit rebates per household.

The Town reserves the right to perform a site visit to verify installation prior to or following issuance of a rebate.

The Town is not responsible for toilet performance or estimated savings, and does not provide any warranties or guarantees, express or implied.

The Town reserves the right to amend and/or discontinue this program without notice.

Only kits purchased after July 25, 2011 are eligible.
