Minutes of meeting – April 24th, 2023

Chairman John McSweeney opened the meeting at 7:03pm.

- 1) There were no public comments
- 2) George Comeau motioned to accept the minutes of the Community Preservation Committee's March 20th minutes as written. The motion was seconded by John Leonetti and passed 5-0-0.
- 3) The March financial reports have not been distributed by town accounting at this time, so they will be reviewed at the May meeting.
- 4) The Revere Copper Roof Project is completed and all funds have been expended. Mr. Comeau made a motion to close the project. The motion was seconded by Kathy McCormack and passed 5-0-0.
- 5) Several committees have sent in feedback regarding updating the Community Preservation Plan; Administrator Neff will compile them (and any other feedback that comes in) into a report for the May meeting.
- 6) The CCPC will have a table at the Canton Heritage Festival on May 20th to do outreach and education about the CPA in Canton. Chairman McSweeney volunteered to take the first shift (10-12:30). Administrator Neff will reach out to absent/past members to find someone to take the second shift (12:30-3).
- 7) Administrator Neff shared a document with the contacts for organizations who applied for CPA funding in the past in order to do outreach and make sure they are aware of the earlier due dates for pre- and full applications this coming summer and fall. Various committee members updated contacts and added new names to the list.
- 8) Mr. Comeau volunteered to be the liaison for the Hagan Court bathroom renovation pre-application which was received.
- 9) The May CCPC meeting will be on May 15th at 7pm in Copper Mill Hall. The June meeting will be on June 12th at 7 in Copper Mill Hall and will be the public Plan input meeting advertised ahead of time.

Mr. Comeau made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:30. The motion was seconded by Ms. McCormack and passed 5-0-0.
