Pequitside Farm located in Canton, MA, is a wonderful place for many people to come and enjoy the fresh air, a membership in the Community Garden, and to sit, play, and walk in nature. The Canton Conservation Commission, which manages Pequitside Farm, has had requests over the years to add memorial benches to the property in honor of a loved one for whom this property held special meaning. If you are interested in donating a bench for Pequitside Farm, please complete this form and return it to the Conservation Office on the 2nd Floor of the Lynch House at 79 Pleasant Street along with a check for \$1200 made payable to “Town of Canton” with *Pequitside Bench* in the notes section. This amount covers the cost of the bench, delivery, installation, and the plaque with engraving, and any remaining proceeds are donated into the revolving fund used by the Commission for property maintenance.
