PLEASE DO NOT RECYCLE THE

FOLLOWING: Place in solid waste container or other acceptable disposal method.

- Styrofoam
- Electronics (CRTS drop off only Pine St.)
- Ceramics or dishes
- Food Waste
- Plastic grocery bags
- Motor oil containers
- Hazardous waste containers
- Plastic bags
- Light bulbs, window glass or mirrors
- Yard waste (Pine Street Yard Waste drop off Facility)

BULK ITEMS: Will be collected curbside. Call 1-800-222-5158 for arrangements 72 hrs in advance.

White goods (appliances) can be collected on Wednesdays.

CRT's can be picked up on the last Friday of each month for a fee of \$15.00.

Please provide proof of residency and the license plate number of the vehicle.

WINTER HOURS - Drop off is Wednesday - Saturday, December 19th - April 1, 2019

Holiday tree drop off is Monday - Saturday the first two full weeks in January
