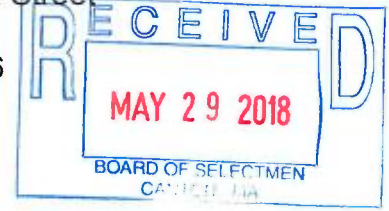

Dear Friends,

It has been through the continued support and donations from the residents and businesses of Canton that our Food Pantry is able to supply the growing number of families and seniors in need.

Over 2,300 people were serviced through our Food Pantry last year, and 40 new families were added in 2017. We supplied over 9,700 bags of food valued at more than \$290,000. In addition, 125 turkey dinners were provided this year during the holidays.

Our Food Pantry is located at 960 Washington Street at the rear of the Marilyn Rodman Center, and is open on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 9:15 AM to 11:15 AM. The Pantry is also open the first Saturday of each month from 10 AM to 10:30 AM. Early on Monday mornings the volunteers stock shelves. Food donations can be dropped off at that time or at the Canton Library, J.L. Pratt Realtors, the Canton Co-operative Bank or the Bank of Canton at both their locations.
