



MBTA COMMUTER RAIL POSITIVE TRAIN CONTROL PROGRAM UPDATE

Advisory: Franklin Line Commuter Rail Overnight Work Continues into January

Work to occur 10 PM-6 AM

MassDOT and the MBTA are undertaking federally mandated Positive Train Control (PTC) infrastructure installation which will increase the safety of commuter rail customers and would like to advise the community of the of overnight work within the right-of-way along the MBTA Franklin Commuter Rail Line. This overnight work is necessary to avoid service interruptions by taking advantage of track time when the trains will not be operating.

Overnight activities by the PTC Systems Integrator Ansaldo STS USA, Inc. are anticipated to continue overnight next week on Wednesday, December 26 and Thursday, December 27, 2018. It is anticipated this overnight work could continue on weeknights through January, 2019. Work will occur as necessary between approximately 10 PM and 6 AM at locations across the entire line.

Due to the equipment necessary to perform this work, lights and mild to moderate noise levels can be expected. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
