

INTERPRETIVE SIGNAGE at Paul Revere Heritage Site



CPA Applicant: Paul Revere Heritage Commission

Funding Request: \$71,783

- ❖ The proposed project represents a further capital improvement to the new open space at the Paul Revere Heritage Site that will welcome and inform visitors and tell the story of the site's natural and historic resources.
- ❖ Up to twenty-five signs will cover topics including (among others) the flora and fauna found on the site; the history of the Revere family at this location; the changes to the site over time; and the recent transformation of the property.
- ❖ Applicant secured a grant totaling \$10,000 from the Simoni Foundation for the proposed project. Additionally, the Department of Public Works committed to installing the signs; an in-kind donation valued at approximately \$7,000. Accordingly, the CCPC recommended a funding amount which took into account the funds leveraged following the submittal of the original application.

CCPC voted to recommend funding in the amount of \$55,000
