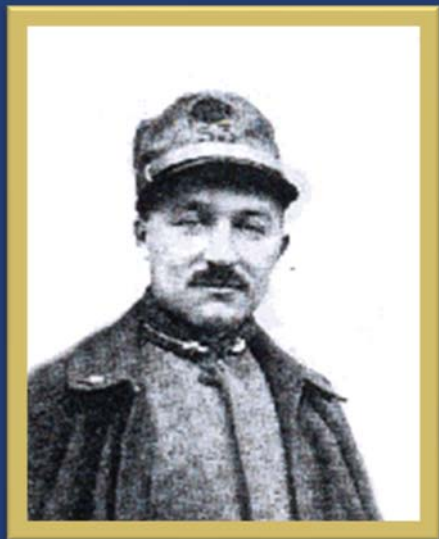


## *World War I*

*Born -December 3, 1890 ..... Gattinara, Italy*  
*Entered Service - 1915 .... Gattinara, Italy*

Ettore emigrated from Gattinara, Italy in 1910 to live with his uncle. Many Gattinara, Italy families did so to work in the leather industry. They lived in the Neponset Street and Norfolk Street area of Canton. After five years living here, he returned to Italy to enlist in the Italian Army Six months after his enlistment, Italy joined the allied forces against Germany and Austria. Ettore was attached to the 7th Company of the 252nd Infantry. Nine months after the end of the war, Ettore was still listed as on active duty; but early in 1920 the sad news arrived that he had been killed in action at II Bertta in one of the battles of Piave River. December 13, 1917. Although Gattinara Italy was the same size as Canton, over one hundred servicemen were lost during WWI.
