*Born* - May 27, 1912 ..... Mansfield, Massachusetts  
*Entered Service* - August 10, 1943 ... Canton, Massachusetts

Mike grew up in Mansfield with his three brothers and sisters, graduating from Mansfield High in 1930. He also attended Cushing Academy in Ashburnham and a year at St. Anselm's College. Mike then joined his father Joseph in managing "Moro's Meat Market" located across from St. John's Church. He Married Helen Owens of Norwood in November 1939, bought a house at 858 Pleasant Street and had a son ( John Michael ) March 20,1943. Before his son was five months old, he was drafted into the Army joining his three brothers who were already serving in other branches of service. Julian shipped out June 16, 1944 to reinforce troops in France after " D " Day. After only two weeks of combat, he was seriously wounded July 30, 1944 in fierce fighting near St. Lo. He was evacuated to England and died there August 2nd.
