Shayne grew up in Franklin, Mass where he completed his Primary education and enjoyed playing Pop Warner football. He then entered Tri County Regional Technical School and competed with the wrestling team. Shayne transferred to Canton High in 2003 when he moved to Canton and graduated with the class of 2004. He was known for his infectious smile, positive personality and likeable demeanor which may have been developed as the middle child of seven siblings. Cabino entered the Marine Corps October 17, 2004 and after 12 weeks of training at Parris Island S.C. , advanced infantry training at Camp Lejeune N.C. And being stationed in California he was sent to Iraq to join up with Company "G" 2nd Battalion of the 2nd Marines. Less than three months after he arrived Cabino perished on a mission 50 miles west of Baghdad in the Town of Karmah when his vehicle was hit by a roadside bomb.
