

1829 Hunneman Hand Tub Restoration

Applicant: Canton Historical Society

Project Cost: \$46,000

CPA Funding Requested: \$46,000

- ❖ Rare artifact manufactured by the Wm. Hunneman Co. of Boston dates back to 1829 when it was purchased by the volunteer fire company in Ponkapoag.
- ❖ Hunneman apprenticed under Paul Revere and it is extremely likely that the copper used in constructing the hand tub (fire pumper) came from Revere's Copper Rolling Mill in Canton.
- ❖ CPA funds will be used to preserve the artifact which will be on long-term loan to the Town of Canton for public display at the Revere Museum of Discovery and Innovation.
